Tripura Engineering College (Now NIT Agartala) (02-11-1965 to 15-07-1982)**
Born: 28-10-1920
Death: 18-08-2011 (2 P.M.)

Late Prof M. L. Das Gupta

- Born in the year of 1920 in East Bengal presently known as Bangladesh.
- Graduated in Electrical Engineering from Bengal Engineering College, Shibpur in 1942.
- Served TISCO, Jamshedpur for five years.
- Selected for GOI Scholarship for studying Post Graduate degree in USA.
- Completed MS from New York State University in 1950.
- On his return from USA he joined as Faculty member in Electrical Deptt. of BE College where he served till 1965 as Associate Professor and Head of the Deptt. of Electrical Engineering.
- In 1965 he was given the responsibility of establishing Tripura Engineering College, where he served as founder Principle till his retirement in 1982.

He was actively associated with Institute of Engineers(India), Kolkata. Expert member in both State & Union Public Service Commission.

Reached heavenly abode on 18th August 2011 survived by his wife, son Sanjay Das Gupta, Ex Dy. Director and outstanding scientist in ISRO & daughter Dr. Chaitali Sen Gupta.
